

Competition By-laws

Morley Sport & Recreation Centre promotes a safe, FRIENDLY and competitive social sporting competition.

We hope you have an enjoyable season with us!

MSRC By-laws are in place and are strictly enforced to provide the highest quality competition possible. It is important that EVERY player reads and understands the By-laws.

FIXTURES

- All teams must be prepared to play ALL time slots and fixtured games during the course of the season.
- All fixtures are available on our website www.morley.ymcawa.org.wa
- Check fixtures weekly for any updates.

GAME COMMENCEMENT

- Score sheets must be filled out before commencement of the game with player's full names; this will count as player attendance.
- Players must ensure that they are on court and ready to start on time, otherwise late points will apply.

GAME FEES

- The team captain must pay the team game fee to reception, collect a receipt and submit it to the umpire prior to commencement of the game.
- The game will not start until your teams receipt is received.

FILL IN PLAYERS

- Teams can play a fill in player so long as the fill in player meets the criteria set out in the bylaws.
- Teams may have a fill in player to make the FIFTH player only. (Basketball specific)
- A fill in player is allowed to play for one team only per night (in wing positions only – netball specific)
- A fill in player can become a registered player and qualify for finals if their name and details are recorded on the Team nomination sheet by the end of the regular season and that they have played 4 games with the same team during that season and DO NOT play for another team on the same night.
- A REGISTERED player is only allowed to fill in for one extra game per night for a team in the same grade or higher than the team they are registered for.

FINALS ELIGIBILITY

- To qualify for finals, players must have **played 4 games** during the season for the team.
- Teams that owe fines or fees will not be eligible for finals, regardless of their ladder placing.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Captains are expected to accept ultimate responsibility for team conduct and adherence by team members to competition by-laws.

UNIFORMS

- A uniform consists of a team wearing an identically coloured top with a number / position clearly displayed on at least the back of the shirt or bibs in the case of netball only.
- Bibs and taped on numbers will not be considered as uniform for soccer and basketball.
- The wearing of non-marking shoes is essential.
- Shorts must be of a similar shade, Jeans, ripped t-shirts or any similar attire will not be allowed on court. The umpire has the right to make judgment on the uniform and impose THE PENALTY OF 2 POINTS PER PLAYER OUT OF UNIFORM based on the above guidelines.
- Netball teams are strongly advised to provide their own bibs for reasons of hygiene and the limited availability of hire sets.

FORFEITS/WITHDRAWALS

• The fines are as follows and are strictly enforced:

Forfeit Fines \$136.00 Basketball and/or Soccer \$152.00 Netball

Withdrawal Fine \$170.00

NEW SEASON

- Nomination forms for the next season will be available to all teams before the end of the current season.
- It is the team representative's responsibility to organise the team nomination and submit it on time, in order to secure a spot in the competition.
- Competition points apply from week one of new season. New season commences during previous season Grand final night.
