



Wheatbelt Athlete Support Program (WASP)

SPORT SUPPORT FUNDING GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

WASP Sport Support Funding (SSF) is accessible by State Sporting Associations (SSAs) who deliver services within the Wheatbelt Region; to enhance talent development programs and pathways within the region. The SSF offers the opportunity for SSAs to source funding to provide access to additional sport specialist services that support the development of high performance athletes in their talent development programs or squads.

Examples of eligible programs which may be supported under WASP SSF include:

- Access to sports specialist coaching and programs for high performance athletes;
- Access to quality facilities and personal trainers through tailored exercise programs; and
- Access to specialist coaching within the Wheatbelt region.

To be eligible for WASP Sport Support Funding applicants must:

- **Contact the WASP Co-ordinator to discuss their application.**
- Provide services within the Wheatbelt Region.
- Be a State Sporting Association with the intention to enhance talent development programs within the Wheatbelt region.
- Demonstrate consideration of future sustainability of the program.
- Be able to demonstrate a partnership with the relevant sporting club or association based in the Wheatbelt to deliver the program.
- All applicants must ensure previous funding granted by WASP has been acquitted and there are no outstanding reporting requirements

SSF will be available for up to \$2,000 for each application.

Ineligible items include:

- **The purchase of equipment or uniform costs; and**
- **Catering costs.**

WASP financial support should not be used to fully fund an organisations activities, programs or initiatives. The support is a competitive grant program and as such, applications that demonstrate a financial or in-kind contribution from an individual or club will be viewed favorably.



Acquittal Requirements

All applicants who receive funding support through WASP will be required to:

1. Acquit the funds appropriately as determined by WASP;
2. Provide details of outcomes including learnings, successes, improvements etc. on a short report at the conclusion of the funding period (template to be provided); and
3. Provide a Statement of Expenditure with supporting documentation (i.e. receipts); and
4. Provide proof of completion of the Developing Champions on-line program, if applicable.

How to apply

Key dates for WASP Funding rounds 2018:

- **WASP FUNDING ROUND 1**
 - **Applications open 1 February 2018 to 28 February 2018**
 - **Eligible programs must be completed between 1 January 2018 to June 2018**
- **WASP FUNDING ROUND 2**
 - **Applications open 1 July 2018 to 8 August 2018**
 - **Eligible programs must be completed between 2 July 2018 to 31 December 2018**

How to submit your Application:

Applications are submitted via an online link. All potential applicants are required to contact the WASP Co-ordinator via phone or email to discuss their application. Once the Co-ordinator has determined the eligibility of your program the online link will be provided.
