

Conditions of Entry

The Y WA is committed to ensuring a child-safe environment for all children and young people

- 1. Observe and follow all signs and instructions from Y staff. They are in place for your safety and comfort.
- 2. Comply with all relevant laws and regulations.
- 3. The use, possession, or influence of illegal drugs/alcohol is not permitted on our premises and persons must not supply alcohol or drugs to children and young people in accordance with our Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 4. Abusive, distruptive, offensive behaviour or language is unacceptable at the Y WA.
- 5. Respect the rights and diverse needs of all children and young people in line with our Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy and procedures. Do not make derogatory, culturally insensitive, or other inappropriate comments whilst at the Y WA.
- 6. Provide the Y WA with all required information including any requests for identification, insurance information or other information as necessary.
- 7. Promptly report any incidents or safety concerns to a Y staff member.
- 8. By entering our premises, you consent to these Conditions of Entry.

The Y WA wants everyone to enjoy a safe environment. Individuals may be excluded from participating in programs and services if they are adversely affected by alcohol or drugs or if they demonstrate inappropriate and unacceptable standards of behaviour that contravene the Y WA's Code of Conduct.
